The BBC have worked hard to create a number of different resources for young people at this time. Here is a brief guide to the resources available for you to use.

BBC Teach

Within this website there are so many resources, it is easy to get lost.

Start with the subject tab <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/secondary/zkqp47h>

Pick the subject within your child's age range. Year 7,8 and 9 can be using the 11-14 subjects, whereas Years 10 – 11 should be using the 14-16 pages.

BBC education have matched up the materials to the curriculum that schools are delivering so look at the list we have provided for you and use a clip to further this particular area of learning.

For example:

- Year 8 in Religious Studies have been learning about the religion of Islam, so this page of clips are very beneficial to watch <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/religious-studies-ks2-my-life-my-religion-islam/znm47h>
- The young people can then create a mind map on this information, or design a PowerPoint to teach it to other people.

Within BBC Teach there is the Live lessons tab, click on this and encourage your children to watch these alongside the work packs we have provided for you.

For example:

Here you will find many learner guides on specific topics, clips and tests. We would suggest that you encourage the young person to revise and look at the guides first.

Choose the tab for the right age group. Year 7, 8 and 9 are KY3 and Year 10, 11 are GCSE. (You can encourage year 9 students to also use the GCSE tab if they find the key stage 3 materials too easy!)

For example:

- Go to Bitesize home page: <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize>
- Click on Secondary, this opens up a new page and you should choose ENGLAND and either KY3 or GCSE, this takes you to a new page, scroll down and the subjects are listed.
- Click on this subject and another page will open with all the materials.
- Click on KY3 Science
- Click on Biology- here you will find masses of learner guides and also class clips.
